ELIGIBLE MEDICAL EXPENSES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Emergency treatment for sickness or injury, whether in-patient or out-patient• Services of physician, surgeon, anesthetist, registered graduate nurse, nursing aid• X-rays, laboratory and diagnostic services• Crutches, casts, splints, canes, slings, trusses, braces, walkers; rental of a wheelchair, iron lung, or hospital type bed
EMERGENCY TRANSPORTATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Licensed ground ambulance• Air ambulance• Medical repatriation up to \$10,000
PRESCRIPTION DRUGS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Prescription medications required for emergency medical treatment
PARAMEDICAL SERVICES AND PRIVATE DUTY NURSING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Services of physiotherapist, chiropractor, chiropodist, podiatrist, or osteopath• Services of a registered private duty nurse
TRANSPORTATION TO BEDSIDE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Up to \$5,000 for round trip economy airfare for one chaperone, medical attendant, or family member, and up to \$3,000 for costs incurred after arrival
SPECIFIC LOSS INDEMNITY	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Accidental Death & Dismemberment: Up to \$25,000 per covered loss, to an aggregate limit of \$50,000• Paralysis: Up to \$50,000 per accident• Prosthetic appliances due to accident: \$2,000
TRIP CANCELLATION / INTERRUPTION	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Trip cancellation up to \$5,000• Trip interruption up to \$25,000• Incidental expenses due to trip cancellation/interruption up to \$350 per day to \$1,500 maximum• Up to \$2,500 for one-way economy airfare for an insured person to rejoin the trip
LOST OR DAMAGED BAGGAGE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• \$375 per item, to a maximum of \$1,500• Up to \$100 for stolen personal currency• Up to \$200 for necessary toiletries if checked baggage is delayed over 12 hours• Up to \$100 for repairs or rental replacement of a damaged wheelchair
